Hollywood heavyweight David Geffen spent some \$10 million revamping this 47-room luxury hotel. Located on Carbon Beach, a private and exclusive strip of sand with a celebrity quotient so high locals call it Billionaire's Beach, the Malibu Beach Inn's guest rooms are outfitted in refined and contemporary neutral tones and come equipped with everything you need to play privileged: 32-inch plasma television, iPod docking station, a view of the ocean (every room has a view, though some are only partial), 24-hour room service, a minibar stocked with California wines and, perhaps most importantly, direct access to the beach. Some of the rooms have gas fireplaces. The inn's restaurant, the Carbon Beach Club, continues to cater to the elite with entree prices running \$30 to \$50. But if you're staying at the Malibu Beach Inn, you're already living large. And the al fresco dining serenaded by crashing waves is priceless.
