THE TOWERS AT THE LOTTE NEW YORK PALACE HOTEL, NEW YORK,

WHAT'S IT LIKE? A grand old dame of the city, the Lotte is in midtown Manhattan, at the corner of 50th Street and Madison Avenue. The 55-storey hotel has a grand lobby area and sweeping staircase and 822 guest rooms and 87 suite.

ANY ROOMS

GOOD? Good is an understatement.

The room was huge. The bathroom was classy with walk in shower and the gigantic bed sumptuously comfy. They also have massive Tower Corner Suites if you are feeling flush.

WHAT ELSE? Some rooms have full on views of the beautiful St. Patrick's Cathedral, while others have skyline views. Mine even managed to sneak in

the Chrysler Building — my fave building in the world.

EAT HERE OR GRAB A PIZZA? There isn't a restaurant at the hotel but they're planning to open one for breakfast soon. But there are plenty of great places nearby for eating.

SO YOU'D GO BACK? Definitely. If there wasn't so much to see in the Big Apple I would have stayed in my room for the entire trip.

WHAT'S THE DAMAGE? Rooms start from \$380 per night and Towers Corner suites at \$1200 per night. They also have a Summer Like a Local special on two night stays until August 30 with ten per cent off best rates and 50 per cent off on Sundays. There's also 20 per cent off suites and comp Wi-Fi.
