

Woody Allen: "I Don't Even Know What Tweeting Is"

While New York men's fashion week parties dominated Wednesday night's social calendar, plenty of designers, socials, and models took a break to catch the Cinema Society's screening of Woody Allen's latest flick, Irrational Man, which stars, among others, Emma Stone and Joaquin Phoenix.
