Deno's Wonder Wheel @ Coney Island

New York Police Museum

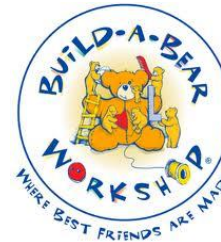
