

Student Ministry Intern

Purpose:

The primary purpose of the internship is to be a learning opportunity through relational ministry to middle and high school students. This experience provides a chance to gain practical ministry training, work in an atmosphere of personal and professional guidance and support, test their gifts and call to vocational ministry, and develop spiritually and theologically.

Responsible To:

The intern will be directly responsible to the HAC Student Ministries Pastor. The Intern will also take part in staff meetings weekly, and be a responsible team player amongst the other members of the staff.

Description/Expectations/Responsibilities:

- Growing personal relationship and commitment to Jesus Christ, the Body of Christ, and God's work in the world. Spend regular time in personal Bible study/devotional to maintain your own spiritual health outside of ministry.
- Adhere to the C&MA Statement of Faith.
- Able to present the Gospel of Jesus Christ to students and encourage them in their spiritual growth.
- Work with Student Ministries Pastor to plan and carry out summer activities as outlined in the calendar.
- Develop relationships with students, parents and volunteers through individual and group contact, e-mail, phone, & social media.
- Meet weekly for study, prayer, planning, evaluation and communication.
- Lead activities and events when the Oasis Student Ministries pastor is away. Teaching as directed and as opportunities avail themselves.
- Responsible for administrative tasks as needed.
- Meet with students in HAC each week outside of regularly scheduled activities and events.
- Support HAC staff in congregational events and goal achievements.
- Each intern will have required reading for the summer.

The applicant must also meet the standards set out as per our gov't grant guidelines:

- a) is between 15 and 30 years of age (inclusive) at the start of employment;
- (b) was registered as a full-time student during the preceding academic year;
- (c) intends to return to school on a full-time basis during the next academic year;
- (d) is a student in a secondary, post-secondary, CEGEP (Quebec only), vocational or technical program;
- (e) is a Canadian Citizen, permanent resident, or person on whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act* and;
- (f) is legally entitled to work according to the relevant provincial / territorial legislation and regulations

Time Commitment:

- Full-time (approx. 30 hours per week). (July–August) with specific dates to be determined.
- Hours will include some nights and weekends depending on scheduled activities
- You will be expected to take one day off per week in addition to Saturday.
- Wage: \$12/hr
