Maitland Pedigree.

Thomas de Mautlant witnessed a Charter of the Lands of Rasam to John Landales at the End of the Reign of King William the Lion, Died Anno 1228.

II. William de Mautlant, Witness to several of the Charters in King Alexander the Seconds time Died Anno 1250.

III. Sir Richard de Mautlant Kn' was in possession of the Lands & Barony of Aricia dau'r & heir of Thomas de Thirlestane. Thirlestane also other Lands in Berwickshire in the time of Alexander III.

IV. William de Mautlant, confirmed to the Monastery of Dryburgh various Grants by his Father of the Lands of Thirlestane, He joined King Robert Bruce & died 1315.

V. Sir Robert Maitland had possession of the Lands of Thirlestane in his fathers life time 1293. . . Sister of Sir Robert Keith, Marischal of Scotland, He had a Charter of his Lands in Leighington from Sir John Gifford of Yester confirmed who was killed in the same Battle. 17 Oct. 1345 by King David II, Killed with his brother at the Battle of Durham 17 Oct. 1346.

VI. John Maitland of Thirlestane Eldest Son & heir, in 1360 George Dunbar Earl of March disponded to him the Barony of Tibbers in the Parish of Penpunt in Dumfries Shire, Died Anno 1395.

Lady Agnes Dunbar dau'r of Patrick Earl of March.

William Maitland 2 Son Witness to Charters with his brother John, of One Robert Lauder in the time of King David II.

Robert Maitland 3 Son.

. . . dau'r & heir of . . . Gight of Aberdeenshire.

VII. Sir Robert Maitland of Thirlestane Kn' Died Anno 1434. Maria dau'r of James Scrymshire of Dudhope, Constable of Dundee.

Robert Maitland eldest Son was One of of the Hostages for the Ransom of King James I A° 1424 Died S. P. in his Fathers life time.

VIII. William Maitland of Thirlestane & Leighington 2 but eldest surviving Son, Died after 1450.

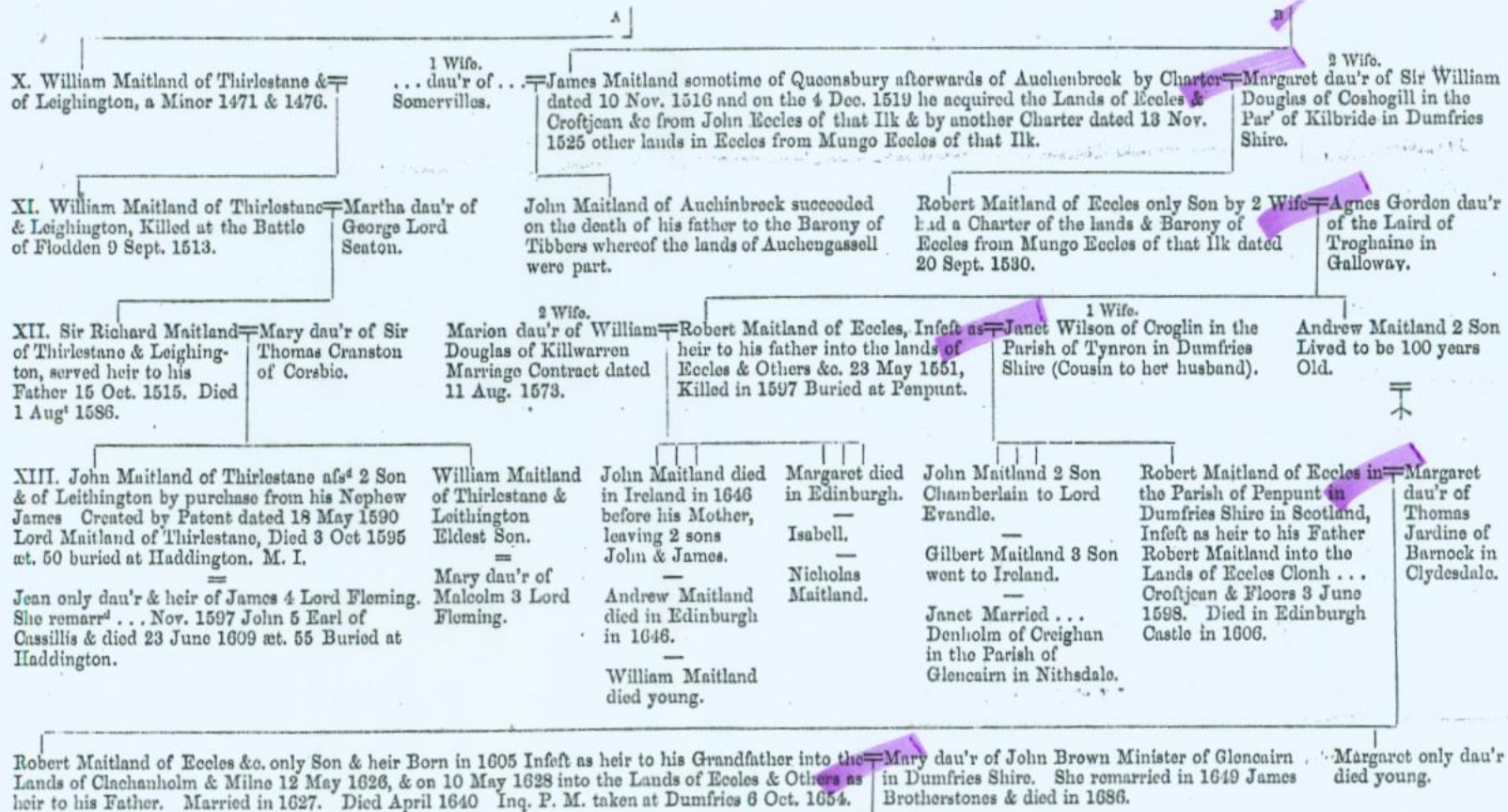

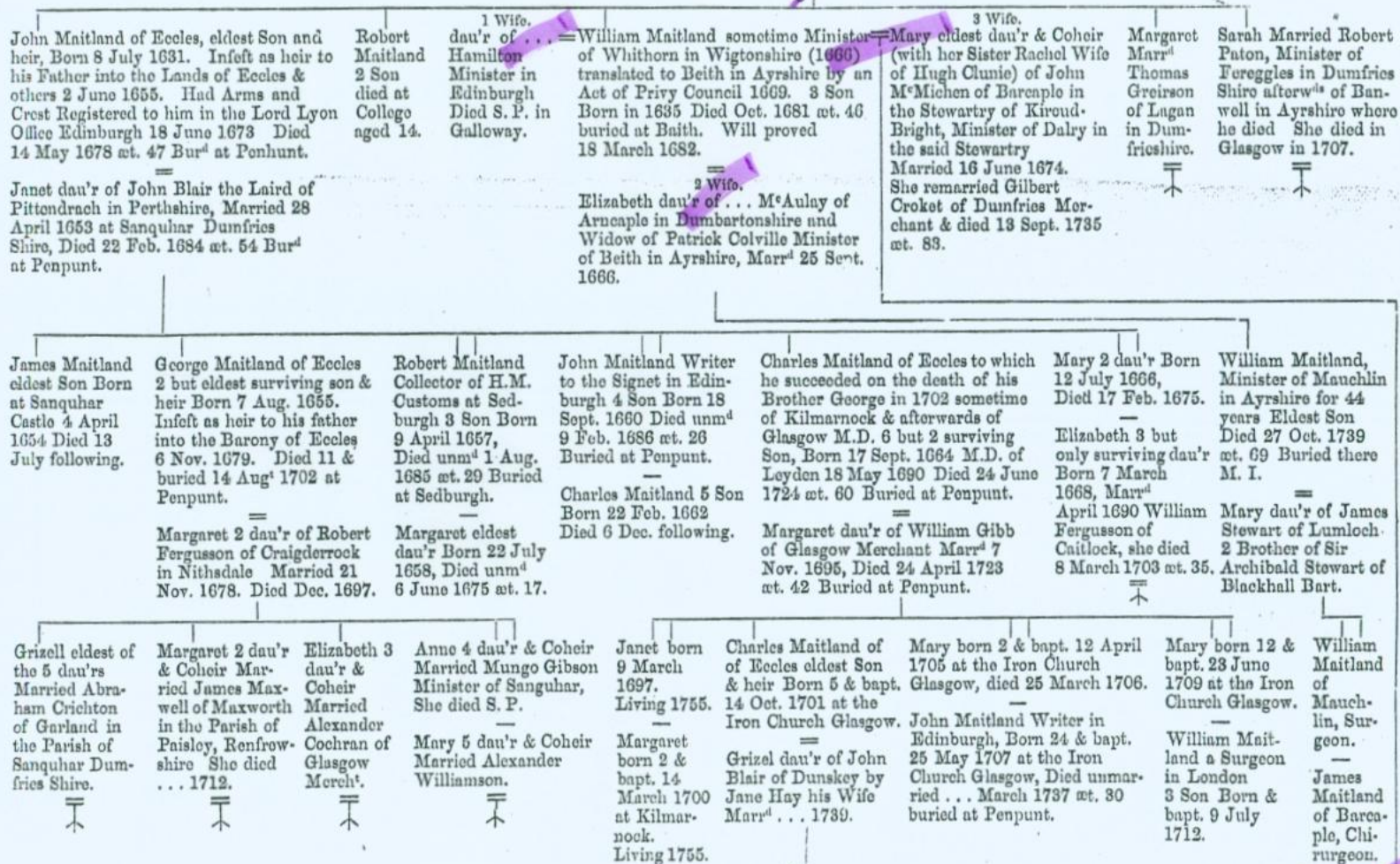

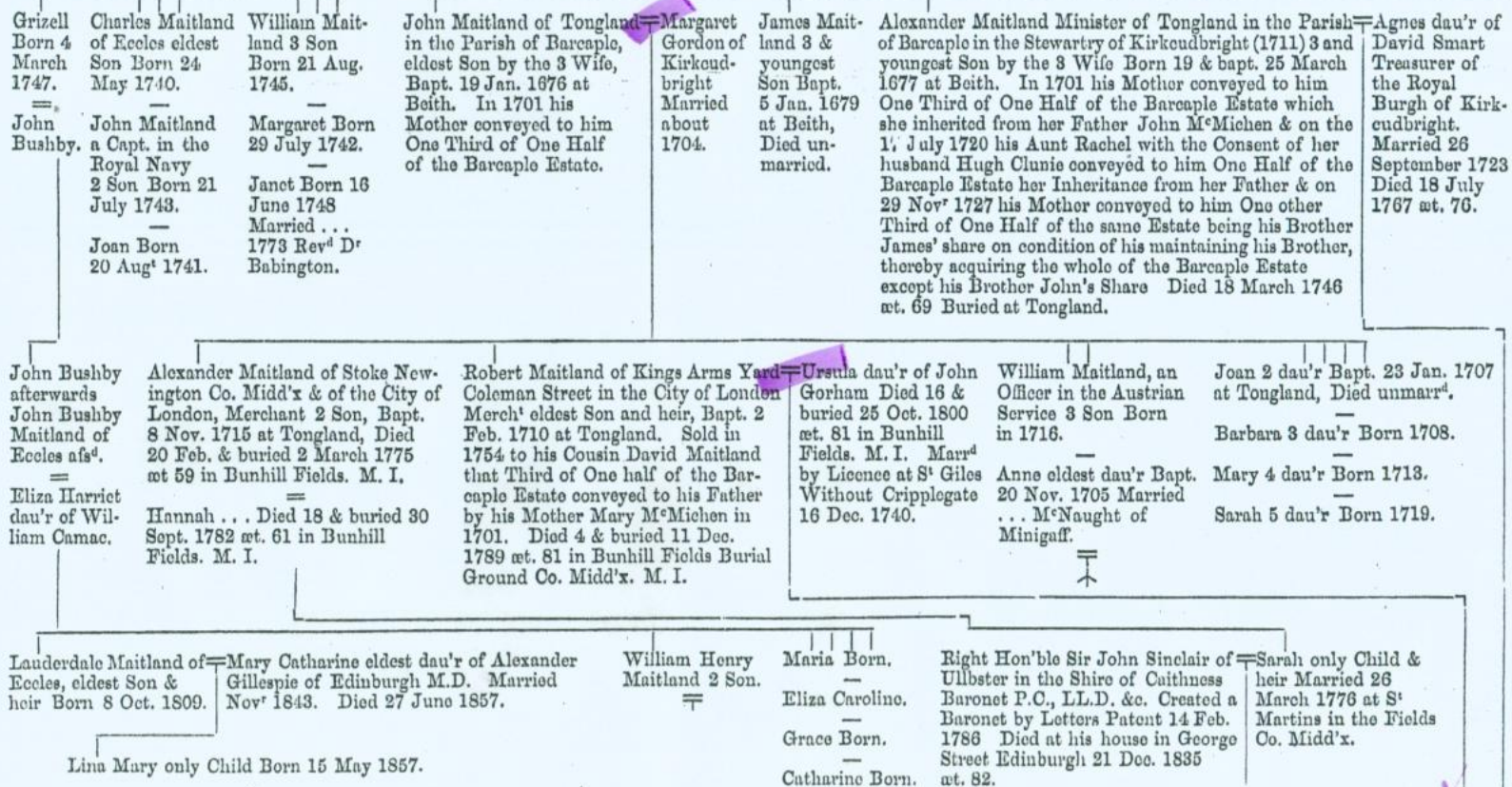
Egidia dau'r of James Scrymshire of Dudhope, Constable of Dundee.

In 1848 he purchased the Estate called High Barcaple of Elizabeth Agnes Maitland. Died at Brighton Co. Sussex 1 Nov. 1858 mt. 78 Buried at Stausted Mountfitchet Co. Essex, 6.
