 havinge had his portion already. Item I give vnto my Daughter Anne the wife of  
 Aramund Cradock Tenne shillings, in full satisfaction of her childes parte, shee  
 havinge had her portion already. Item I give vnto my Daughter Elizabeth White  
 Tenne shillings in full satisfaction of her childes parte, shee havinge had her  
 portion already. Item I give to every one of my Grandchildren which I shall bee  
 livinge at the tyme of my decease, Tenne shillings a peece. Item all the rest and  
 residue of all my goods and chattells aswell reall as personall, Tenne shillings Debt  
 and rentis of houses, My Debt paid, my funerall charged, dynged and my  
 legacies satisfied, I give and bequeath to my Sonne William Deboy whom I  
 make and ordayne the sole Executor of this my present will, not doubtinge but  
 hee will fully and honestly performe and discharge all thinges herein contented.
