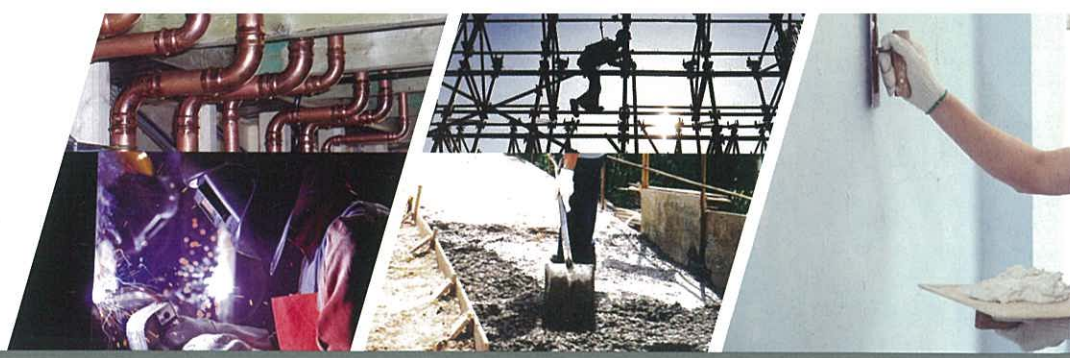

## Skills Enhancement Courses for Ethnic Minorities

In order to train up ethnic minorities who are Registered General Workers to become Semi-skilled Worker, the Construction Industry Council (CIC) offers a series of skills enhancement course. The workers can therefore be employed as Registered Semi-skilled Workers of the related trade divisions and can independently carry out construction works of specified trade divisions on construction sites after the implementation of "designated skills for designated workers". A bonus of HK\$4,000 will be awarded to those who comply with the requirements and obtain intermediate trade test qualification.

### Course Information

- M01: **Metal Scaffolding**
- Read and understand design drawing
  - Temporary struts, supports and connection of metal scaffolding
- M02: **General Welding**
- Electric arc welding / cutting
  - Oxy-acetylene gas welding / cutting
- M03: **Plumbing**
- Connection of various types of pipe and fitting
  - Installation of sanitary wares
- M04: **Concreting**
- Method of placing concrete
  - Practise casting of concrete components and connecting concrete pipes
- M05: **Plastering**
- Understand plastering materials and mortar, hand and mechanical mixing of Mortar
  - Skills training in all plastering and slab paving

### Admission Requirements

- Aged 18 or above ethnic minorities in Hong Kong
- Holder of Registered General Worker (RGW) Card; and
- At least 1 year working experience in relevant trade
- Applicant for General Welding (M02) course must hold the certificate of "Gas Welding Safety Training Course"

### Course Fee

**Free tuition**

The attendance rate of 85% or above is required. The CIC will recommend trainees to take intermediate trade test and the trainees will need to pass the Intermediate Trade Test within 3 months after completion of training. Intermediate Trade Test fee can be waived for a maximum of 2 times. Trainees will **receive a bonus** at **\$4,000** upon passing of the Intermediate Trade Test within 3 months after completion of training
