Sermon Title: When Grace is Forgotten

Scripture text(s): Jonah 3-4

- 1) Have you ever forgotten the grace God has shown you? If so, how did God get your attention?
- 2) In what ways do we try to sabotage the mission God has us on because of our unrepentant hearts? How does God override our sabotage to bring about His purpose?
- 3) What was the difference between the Ninevites and Jonah?
- 4) What was Jonah's biggest issue?
- 5) Discuss how God continued to show Jonah kindness and mercy in spite of Jonah's bitterness.
- 6) How has God shown you mercy and kindness?
- 7) In what ways does God want you to show mercy and compassion to others?
- 8) In his sermon, Richard made the point that Jonah couldn't find joy in God's grace because he thought he deserved the plant God had provided. How do we get caught up in this same heart attitude?
- 9) Jonah's main concern was that the Ninevites were getting away with their sin. Discuss how we can have this same attitude and how it affects our relationships with others and with God?
- 10) How are you going to end this story? With bitterness or joy?
