Cut material for cuffs according to patterns. Cut Velcro material for cuffs to correct sizes using automatic cutter. Cut and assemble materials for durable digit cuffs and disposable digit cuffs.

Sew cuff covers and apply silk screen labeling to cuffs.

Prepare material for RF welding machine. Operate RF welding machine for construction of cuff bladders. Operate table-top production machinery to prepare cuff materials, including punching holes and sealing digit cuff bladders.

Keep track of materials used in construction of cuffs and notify purchasing department of necessary order requirements in a timely manner.

Package cuffs for shipment to customers. Pull cuffs to fill customer orders, then prepare shipments for transport.

Organize storage of raw materials on hand and of finished goods.

Keep inventory control records, keep track of built inventory and report production numbers to production planner for updating inventory and accounting records.

Skills required include:

- Must have the ability to perform quality work with consistency, while following detailed documentation and quality procedures.
- Must be able to demonstrate excellent hand-eye coordination and manual dexterity.
