









WHOLE INCH SIZES (bullnose and edge glazing available on long, short and adjacent edges of all flat bricks)



Flat bricks are are 1/2" thick. Brick are sized to be installed with a 3/16" grout joint.


BASE AND CAP BRICK (trim bricks are available with Stop End and Stop and Return edge treatments)









2" x 4" Running Bond (loose)


Variation is intrinsic to the beauty and warmth of handmade ceramic tile. Differences in size, shape, and glaze color from tile to tile and even within a single tile are intentional and should be expected. Each glaze image above has a label to communicate the amount of variation one can expect from a glaze. The reference diagrams and photos at right show the variation ranges possible with Bison Brick.


The Brick has earned an Exterior Grade Rating under the testing standard ASTM C1088-10.

Bison Brick

Bison Brick is made by hand in our Los Angeles studios, where we are proud to continue Southern California's long tradition of art ceramics.

The special look and feel of Bison Brick comes directly from our handmade process. Made for you in small batches by skilled craftsmen, every single piece has its own unique character. We use only real brick clay and the traditional wire cut process, with no molds, texture rollers, or repeating stamps.

The natural variation in color, texture, and shape is our design intent and gives Bison Brick an unmatched warmth and depth of charm.

Bison Brick is available in over 50 studio glazes, from bright glossy whites to modern moody blues and greens. We also make Bison Brick in those classic reds and oranges from glazed brick projects of the past.

The blending of glazed brick's ageless appeal with modern color sensibilities make Bison Brick at home everywhere from a rustic setting to the most sophisticated residential and commercial environments.

Sustainability

Bison Brick is made from 70% post-industrial recycled content: 40% of the clay body used to make the product is ground scrap roofing tile and brick recovered from a solid waste facility in Apple Valley, California; 30% of the clay body is clay recovered from a sand washing operation in Lincoln, California.

Our Los Angeles facilities operate under the strictest environmental regulations in the country. We recycle 100% of the water and clay used in the production of Bison Brick.

Glazed Brick may qualify for the following LEED points:

MR 4.1/4.2: Recycled Content (1–2 points)
MR 5.1/5.2: Regional Materials (2 points)
EQ 4.2: Low-Emitting Materials (1 point)

Usage

Bison Brick is suitable for commercial and residential uses, and can be used in wet areas including showers, steam showers, and pools. It has passed the ASTM C 1088 standard, and has earned an Exterior Grade rating, so it can be used outside. Test results are available upon request. Lead Time

Stock Orders ship in approximately 1 week. Made-to-Order projects ship in approximately 5 weeks. Large or custom projects over 2,000 sq. ft. will take 6 to 8 weeks or longer (please call for a current estimate).

Installation

Bison Brick is installed as you would install any tile and does not require special materials or tools. We recommend setting Bison Brick with a $^1/8$ to $^3/_{16}$ inch joint with sanded grout. Consult the current TCNA Tile Installation handbook for the proper installation method for your application.

Maintenance and Care

Bison Brick may be cleaned with any non-abrasive household hard surface cleaning products. Acidic or caustic cleaners are not recommended.
