What is engineered recycled glass stone?

Gilasi combines recycled glass with the impermeability and strength of an aeronautical - grade epoxy. It is not merely durable, it is non-porous, stain - resistant and requires no sealers - ever. Most importantly, it is entirely free of VOCs.

Gilasi, manufactured in Chicago since 2003, has strong environmental credentials. It helps architects earn credit toward USGBC LEED certification, a main goal for environmentally sustainable projects.

That's because all the glass in Gilasi products is recycled and makes up 77 to 85 percent of each piece.

Gilasi Engineered Stone is a durable surface made of aeronautics-grade, VOC-free epoxy and 77 to 85% recycled material. The combination of Gilasi's ingredients results in a non-porous material that enriches any décor.

Superior Materials

Glass: The recycled glass used in Gilasi is sourced locally, from within 250 miles of our manufacturing facility. Its variety is dazzling: from the shards of hand-blown lighting fixtures in a myriad of colors to finely crushed container glass to cubes of oven-door glass from a manufacturer in Chicago's historic meat-packing district, "The Back of the Yards." Each type of glass creates a unique style.

Epoxy: Gilasi's resin is the highest grade available. Our reasons for using it are simple: safety and strength.

Gilasi has evolved beyond standard manufacturing practices which use polyester resins to make solid surfaces to develop new, sustainable and safe procedures. As part of our rigorous process, Gilasi's new epoxy offers a VOC-free environment for our manufacturing team, for fabricators who tool and install Gilasi surfaces, and for our customers. At the same time, the strength, impermeability and durability of this resin are unparalleled.

Gilasi fused is the heart of our one-of-a-kind collection of solid surfaces used for wall cladding and fine furnishings. Fused applications include side, dining and coffee tables, breakfast bars, accent wall paneling and reception desks. Your imagination sets the boundaries.

Every Gilasi fused panel is custom-made to the client's specifications.

All colors from the Gilasi palette -- as well as custom tones -- are available for use in fused, with many choices of wood including black walnut, red and white oak, maple and hickory.

Fused also features live-edge urban-forested timbers. To find them, we work with Chicago-area companies that harvest trees fallen in the city. These companies collect, mill and cure the lumber instead of diverting it to a landfill. We select the finest woodcuts and slabs from their inventories, then merge the wood with our Gilasi recycled-glass stone to create surfaces like no others.
