


Barton & Guestier is one of the oldest and most prestigious wine negociants in Bordeaux. The firm was established in 1725 by Thomas Barton, renowned négociant. Daniel Guestier was a reputed importer of Bordeaux wines into Baltimore, in the British colonies in America, and the one who delivered the wines of Bordeaux that President Thomas Jefferson had ordered from Barton.



## **Bordeaux 2021** "Cuvée Rambaud"

**AOC BORDEAUX** 

Barton & Guestier, owner of Château Magnol in the Bordeaux region, has vinified the most famous French Appellations for almost 3 centuries. This cuvee pays tribute to Germain Rambaud, Thomas Barton's first cellar master.



**Appellation:** AOC Bordeaux

Location: Principally in the Entre Deux Mers and the right bank of the Gironde estuary.

**Grape Varieties:** 85% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Cabernet Franc

Tasting note: Deep purple red. Fruit driven with red and black berries (redcurrant, cherry, and blackcurrant) combined with spicy and toasty notes. Good balance with round and velvety tannins, with a hint of vanilla. A long fruity and spicy finish.

Pairing: Red meat, pâté, cheese.
