Barton & Guestier is one of the oldest and most prestigious wine negociants in Bordeaux. The firm was established in 1725 by Thomas Barton, renowned négociant. Daniel Guestier was a reputed importer of Bordeaux wines into Baltimore, in the British colonies in America, and the one who delivered the wines of Bordeaux that President Thomas Jefferson had ordered from Barton.

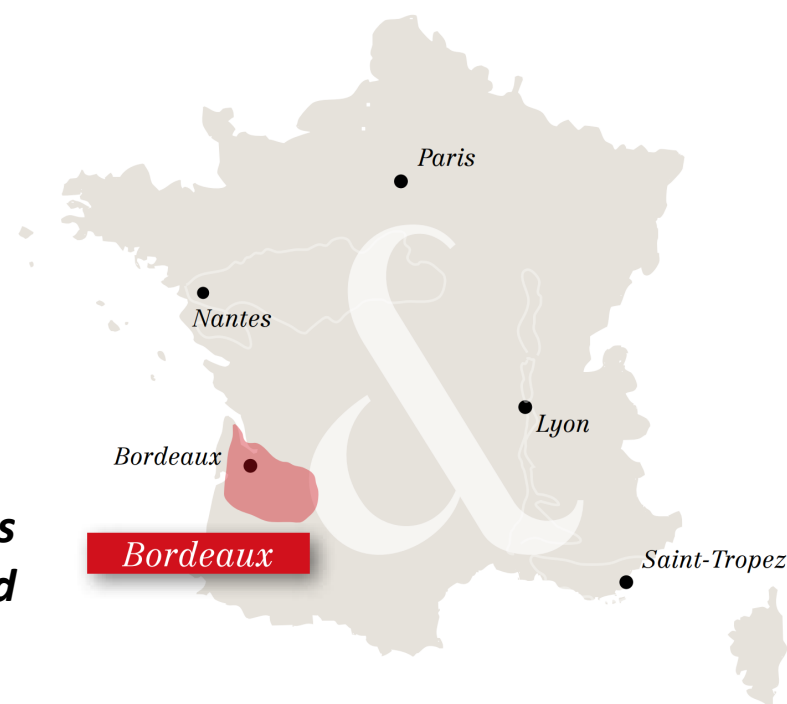

"Petite Nancy"

AOC BORDEAUX

Barton & Guestier, owner of Château Magnol in the Bordeaux region, has vinified the most famous French Appellations for almost 3 centuries. Named after Daniel Guestier's daughter, La Petite Nancy was a famous ship exporting B&G wines throughout the world.



Appellation: AOC Bordeaux Blanc

Location: Vineyard located in the Entre Deux Mers and in the eastern part of the Department

Grape Varieties: 90% Sauvignon Blanc, 10% Semillon

Tasting note: Straw yellow with green highlights. Intense and complex nose of tropical fruits aromas (mango, passion fruit, pineapple) and vanilla notes. Nice lively and rich attack with a citrus note on the aftertaste.

Pairing: Aperitif, seafood or fish dishes.

Winemakers: Florence Tessier, Laurent Prada

Soil: Sandy with gravels and limestone.

Climate: Oceanic

Vines Age: 5-25 years

Harvest starting date: 3rd September 2021

Viticulture: A good year, with a dry and hot summer which resulted in an early harvest and lower yields but promising of quality.

Winemaking: Controlled extraction – Skin contact maceration – low temperature fermentation. Ageing is done 50% in oak and 50% in vats.
