

Barton & Guestier is one of the oldest and most prestigious wine negociants in Bordeaux. The firm was established in 1725 by Thomas Barton, renowned négociant. Daniel Guestier was a reputed importer of Bordeaux wines into Baltimore, in the British colonies in America, and the one who delivered the wines of Bordeaux that President Thomas Jefferson had ordered from Barton.

Barton & Guestier, owner of Château Magnol in the Bordeaux region, has vinified the most famous French Appellations for almost 3 centuries. The region of Anjou is well-known for its magnificent gardens, created for the French Queens during the Renaissance.



Appellation: AOC Rosé d'Anjou

Location: Situated in the Loire Valley, between

Tours and Nantes.

Grape Varieties: 75% Grolleau, 25% Gamay

Tasting note: Bright pink color. Fruit driven with wild strawberries and cherry notes when agitate. Soft and smooth. Well balanced with a long refreshing aftertaste.

Pairing: Aperitif, salads, exotic food, sushi.

Viticulture: The 2021 vintage had a challenging growing season due to difficult weather, resulting in lower yields and a later and longer harvest; however, the wines had a fresh minerality, and bright berry fruit.

Winemaking: De-stalked grapes – maceration period for a few hours – pressing – alcoholic fermentation at a low temperature. Cooling the wine in vats to stop fermentation and leave residual sugar.

Award: Gold medal at the International Challenge by Gilbert & Gaillard in 2021 (vintage 2020)
