Prescription drug use for non-medical reasons is on the rise among high school students.

Education & awareness programs have led to a slight decline in alcohol and marijuana use among our youth.

However, 48.5% of our high school students still report using alcohol and 29.3 % still report using marijuana.

Law Enforcement has reported a 57% increase in drug related arrests from 2015 to 2016.
