Emphasis on technical prowess, creativity, and conceptual development was placed on all projects, gradually increasing with each assignment. Students were taught how to use the camera as an extension of their creative thinking, presenting their efforts in class-led critiques. The critique environment created for my students welcomes diverse opinions aimed to exercise student rights to free speech, with open debates focused on the technical and creative aspects of peer work.
