OVERVIEW

Teams of faculty from partner institutions are invited to share a week-long experientially based workshop with time spent in both rural and urban settings in the Yucatan. Open to faculty of all disciplines, the workshop is designed to build capacity to support broad global learning goals at participants' home institutions by using locations in the Yucatan as a lens through which to explore a range of global issues. Knowledge of Spanish is not required.

ITINERARY

- Airport pickup in Cancun
- Overnight stay in the colonial city of Valladolid followed by a visit to a major Mayan archeological site
- Homestay with a family in Tinum to observe and participate in traditional Maya practices and observe effects of modernization
- Optional excursions: Celestun flamingo reserve, Uxmal, Itzamal
- In Merida: Rosca de Reyes celebration, variety of excursions and activities in the city, guest speakers, discussion, reflection activities.

- Practice integrative, interdisciplinary approaches to learning as applied to complex, real-world questions on site
- Expand capacity for innovative global experiential learning across the curriculum.
