



Notice of Public Hearing

The City of Ingleside in conjunction with Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, September 29, 2015, at City Hall Counsel Chambers, City of Ingleside, 2671 San Angelo Street, Ingleside, Texas 78362. The purpose of the hearing is to present the planned improvements for State Highway (SH) 200, from SH 361 to FM 1069 in San Patricio County, Texas, and to receive public comment. Displays will be available for viewing at 5:00 P.M. with the formal hearing commencing at 7:00 P.M.

The existing conditions are comprised of a former oil refinery and tank farm, although the larger portion consists of undeveloped lands. The project would not displace any residents or commercial structures.

The proposed SH 200 project would provide for a new location, four lane undivided highway, two lanes in each direction with 10 foot shoulders. The proposed typical right-of-way width (ROW) is to be 160-feet. The proposed project is to provide a route around the City's central business area, thereby decreasing traffic congestion and enhance safety along the existing route. The proposed improvements would require approximately 38.3 acres of ROW and would traverse wetlands and the 100-year floodplain of Kinney Bayou.

Maps and other drawings showing the proposed project's location and design will be displayed at the hearing. The Environmental Assessment and other information about the proposed project is on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. at the City Hall of Ingleside, located at 2671 San Angelo Street, Ingleside, Texas 78362 or at the TxDOT Corpus Christi District Office, located at 1701 S. All interested citizens are invited to attend this public hearing. Verbal and written comments from the public regarding this project are requested and may be presented for a period of 10 calendar days following the hearing. Written comments may be submitted either in person or by mail to the City of Ingleside, Mr. Jim Gray, Ingleside City Manager, 2671 San Angelo Street, Ingleside, Texas 78362. Comments must be received on or before Friday, October 9, 2015 in order to become part of the official hearing record.

The Public Hearing will be conducted in English; however, a Spanish interpreter will also be available during the hearing.
