

Broken Heart Angel Wings

Designed by Mary Glynn

This Gown was designed in memory of Baby Marlow. Every time you knit this gown, this will be in honor of Marlow.



This gown will fit a newborn-3 months old
Materials: Lion Brand baby yarn (3 ply), Ribbon, Size 6 circular needle, Size 5 double pointed needles for arms (or you can use circular for arms if you choose) PM: Place Markers (I use a different color yarn)

CO 102 Stitches (Turn, do not connect, leaving back open to dress baby better)
Starting at bottom of gown Purl across. (WS: wrong side)

For curling edge (looks pretty both ways, this is what I did for this gown)

Knit 1 row, Purl 1 row for 5 rows.

Option: For non curling bottom edge Knit every row for 5 rows.

Now to start the hearts...

Note: When working hearts You will work 4 knit stitches at the beg and end of every row (the pattern will not state that) and in between each heart pattern is 2 stitches separating hearts from one another.

Placing markers first

(i.e.: Knit 4, PM, Heart pattern, PM, Knit 2 (for knit row, or purl for purl row) PM, Heart Pattern, PM, Knit 2, PM, Heart Pattern, PM Knit 4)

Heart pattern

Row 1: remember the (i.e and note)

For actual heart pattern

Knit 7, (Yo, K 2 tog) 3 times, K5, (Yo, K 2 tog) 3 times, K 6 (PM do i.e and note here) then repeat pattern across (last 4 stitches do as i.e)

Row 2: Following the (i.e) Purl across, then (i.e.)

Cont to do the (ie. And note) I will not mention in any further in the pattern.

Row 3: K 6, (Yo, K2 tog) 3 times, K 6, (Yo, K 2 tog)

3 times K 6
(repeat pattern

across)

Row 4: Purl (every wrong side row)

Row 5: K 6, Yo, K 2 tog, K 4, Yo, K 2 tog, K 2, Yo, K 2 tog, K 4, Yo, K 2 tog, K 6. (repeat across)

Row 7: K 6, (Yo, K 2 tog) 2 times, K 3, (Yo, K 2 tog) 2 times, K 3, (Yo, K 2 tog) 2 times, K 6. (repeat across)

Row 9: K 6, (Yo, K 2 tog) 2 times, K 4, (Yo, K 2 tog) 2 times, K 4, Yo, K 2 tog, K 6. (repeat across)

Row 11: K 14, Yo, K 2 tog, K 14. (repeat across)

Row 13: K 13, (Yo, K 2 tog) 2 times, K 13. (repeat across)

Row 15: K 13, (Yo, K 2 tog) 2 times, K 13. (Repeat across)

Row 17: K 12, Yo, K 2 tog, K 2, Yo, K 2 tog, K 12. (repeat across)

Row 19: K 12, Yo, K 2 tog, K 2, Yo, K 2 tog, K 12. (cont pg 5)

(Cont from page 4) Broken hearts pattern...

Row 21: K 11, Yo, K 2 tog, K 4, Yo, K 2 tog, K 11.

Row 23: K 10, Yo, K 2 tog, K 6, Yo, K 2 tog, K 10.

Row 25: K 9, Yo, K 2 tog, K 8, Yo, K 2 tog, K 9.

Row 27: K 8, Yo, K 2 tog, K 10, Yo, K 2 tog, K 8.

Row 29: K 7, Yo, K 2 tog, K 12, Yo, K 2 tog, K 7.

Row 31: K 6, Yo, K 2 tog, K 14, Yo, K 2 tog, K 6.

Row 33: K 5, Yo, K 2 tog, K 16, Yo, K 2 tog, K 5.

Row 35: K 4, Yo, K 2 tog, K 18, Yo, K 2 tog, K 4.

Row 37: K 3, Yo, K 2 tog, K 20, Yo, K 2 tog, K 3.

Row 39: K 2, Yo, K 2 tog, K 22, Yo, K 2 tog, K 2.

Row 41: Repeat row 39.

Row 43: K 1, Yo, K 2 tog, K 24, Yo, K 2 tog, K 1.

Row 45: K 1, Yo, K 2 tog, K 25, Yo, K 2 tog.

Row 47: Yo, K 2 tog, K 26, K 2 tog, Yo.

Row 49: Repeat row 47

Row 51: Yo, K 2 tog, K 8, Yo, K 2 tog, K 6, Yo, K 2 tog, K 8, K 2 tog, Yo.

Row 53: Yo, K 2 tog, K 6, (Yo, K 2 tog) 3 times, K 2, (Yo, K 2 tog) 3 times, K 6, K 2 tog, Yo.

Row 55: K 1, Yo, K 2 tog, K 6, Yo, K 2 tog, K 2, (Yo, K 2 tog) 2 times, K 2, Yo, K 2 tog, K 6, Yo, K 2 tog, K 1.

Row 57: K 1, Yo, K 2 tog, K 6, Yo, K 2 tog, K 1, Yo, K 2 tog, K 1, Yo, K 2 tog, K 2, Yo, K 2 tog, K 6, Yo, K 2 tog, K 1.

Row 59: K 2 tog, (Yo, K 2 tog) 2 times, K 5, (Yo, K 2 tog) 2 times, K 2, (Yo, K 2 tog) 2 times, K 5, Yo, K 2 tog, K 2.

Row 61: K 2, Yo, K 2 tog, K 10, Yo, K 2 tog, K 10, Yo, K 2 tog, K 2.

Row 63: K 3, Yo, K 2 tog, K 8, (Yo, K 2 tog) 2 times, K 8, Yo, K 2 tog, K 3.

Row 65: K 4, (Yo, K 2 tog) 2 times, K 4, Yo, K 2 tog, K 2, Yo, K 2 tog, K 4. (Yo, K 2 tog) 2 times, K 4.

Row 67: K 5, Yo, K 2 tog, K 3, (Yo, K 2 tog) 2 times, K 2, (Yo, K 2 tog) 2 times, K 3, Yo, K 2 tog, K 5.

Row 69: K 6, (Yo, K 2 tog) 3 times, K 6, (Yo, K 2 tog) 3 times, K 6.

Row 71: K 7, (Yo, K 2 tog) 2 times, K 8, (Yo, K 2 tog) 2 times, K 7.

Starting with purl and taking off markers, Stockenette Stitch for 2 -3 inches.

BODICE

Row 1: K 15 sts, PM, BO (Bind off) 15 sts, Slip last knit st. from BO onto the left needle and CO 15 sts onto left needle, work these 15 sts for arm, then work across until 30 stitches remain, BO 15 sts, slip sts left from right needle to left then CO 15 sts, work the CO 15 sts, then knit until end.

Row 2: Purl 29 sts. (making sure to still do the i.e) Purl 2 sts together, P across until 16 sts remain, the P 2 sts tog (the 15 & 16 th sts) purl across (i.e)

Continue to working in St. St. for 2 more inches remembering the (i.e)

Then,

With Knit row

K 1, K 2 tog across, Then Purl across.

Then, *k 2 tog* across (do the i.e @ beg and end rows)

Row 1; Seed St (K 1, P 1) across (remembering i.e)

Row 2: K 1, P 1 across (3 rows total.)

Then, *K 2, K 2 tog*, 7 times, BO 4 sts, (slip BO, rem sts to left needle K 2 tog, across K 1.

Then work these 8 sts in seed st . BO 1 st by neck edge, per neck edge until 5 sts remain on needle. Then BO do not worry about the knit sts at the beg of rows as in the i.e.

Reconnect yarn, Do the 8 sts the same as last 8 sts.

Sew in ends.

For arms: Pick up stitches all the way around arm hole work in seed stitch for 16 rows each arm.

Bo across.

Weave ribbon from bottom of heart going up and around, down other side to match up with other end making a box. Do all 3 hearts like this. Do ribbon on both arms and the back of the gown..

(another option is to make a eyelet row before starting the bodice) And weaving ribbon in it tying in back of gown.

Hope you enjoy this pattern, Let me know how it turns out for you. Remember all my patterns are basic and I enjoy people adding their own touches..

Nice touch would be a lace bottom border :)
