



## GI Medical Oncology Fellowship at BC Cancer – Vancouver Centre

The BC Cancer - Vancouver Cancer Centre is pleased to announce an opportunity for a 1-2 year Medical Oncology fellowship in GI Medical Oncology, with a focus on neuroendocrine tumors. The successful applicant will spend time in GI Medical Oncology clinics, will be involved in health outcomes and translational research programs, and will help develop a multidisciplinary neuroendocrine program at BC Cancer. Opportunities for formal course work leading to a graduate degree from the University of British Columbia are also available.
