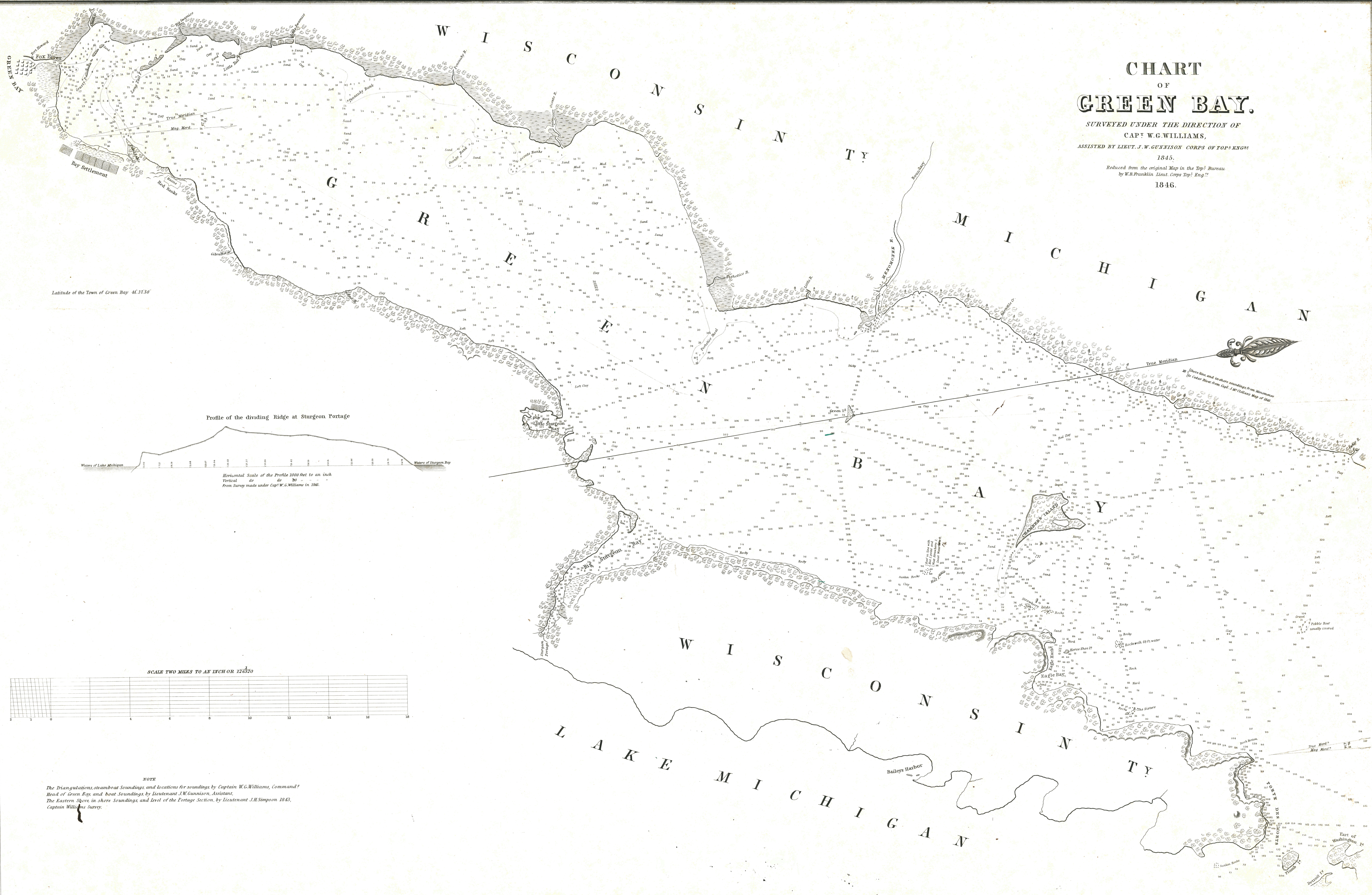


# CHART OF GREEN BAY.
