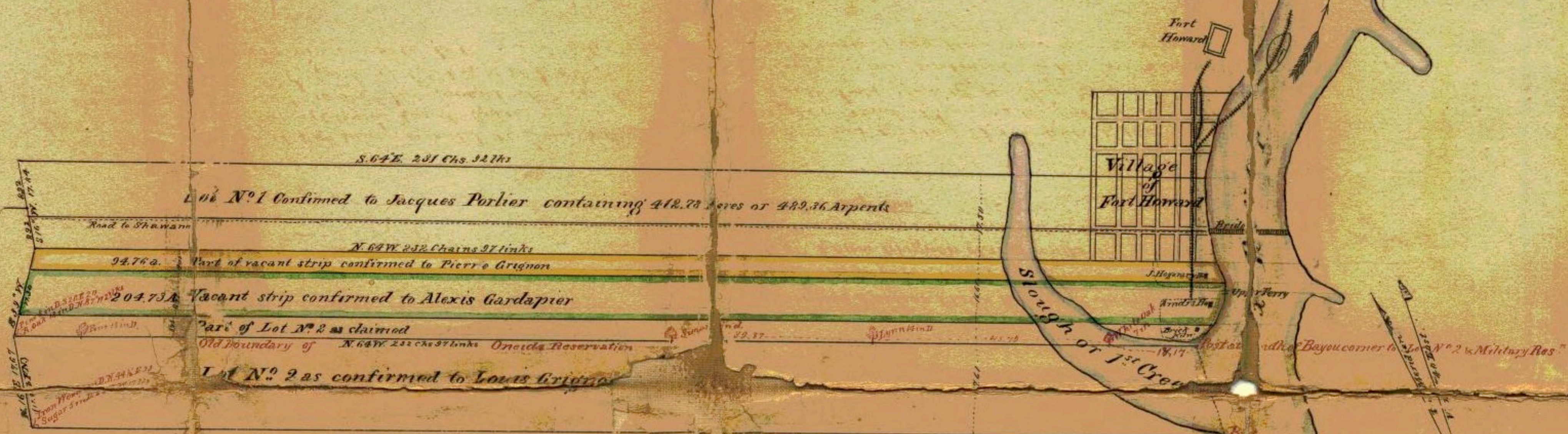


Township N<sup>o</sup>. 24 N. Range 20 East 4<sup>th</sup> Meridian Wisconsin

The above is a correct plat of survey executed by Fred S. Ellis D. S. under contract of May 25 1868 and special instructions from the Commissioner General Land Office of June 5<sup>th</sup> 1868 of the tract of land known as the vacant strip claimed by Alexis Gardapier and part of the vacant strip on the North side of said tract claimed by Pierre Grignon, situated on the West side of Fox River in T. 24 N. R. 20 E. 4<sup>th</sup> Prin. Mer. Wisconsin formerly embraced in the Fort Howard Reservation, is strictly conformable to the field notes of survey thereof which have been examined and approved
