His charity; we beg him to Continue. Our Fathers have promised me to pray for you As you beseech them to. I thank you for the memorandum which you have sent me of the easiest remedies: you do not Realize that they are nevertheless, for the most part, difficult for us, in the dearth of This country; howbeit, I thank you for them with just as good a Heart as if we could employ them. But I beg you to send me some medicinal seeds, As the purgatives, and some other like sorts; if you Cultivate the plants at home, please inform me of their Cultivation and use. I close: ora pro me sine fine, who am, etc.
