Extract from the Royal License.

Y grace and privilege of the King, Sebastien Cramoisy, Sworn Merchant Bookseller in the University of Paris, and Printer in ordinary to the King and to the Queen Regent, Citizen of Paris, is permitted to print, or cause to be printed, a Book entitled, Relation de ce qui s'est passé de plus remarquable és Missions des Peres de la Compagnie de IESUS, en la Nouvelle France, sur le grand fleuve de sainct Laurens, en l'année 1647, envoyée au R. P. Provincial de la Province de France, par le Superieur des Missions de la mesme Compagnie. And this during the time and space of ten consecutive years, with prohibition to all Booksellers and Printers to print, or cause to be printed, the said Book, under pretext of disguise or change that they might make therein; under penalty of confiscation and the fine imposed by the said License. Given at Paris, the 27th of January, 1648.
