

{ François takwatchisenapeou—"the little big Man"—is the son of the wife of Kikwanou.
pierre pepakousinagoutieou—"he who always looks sick"—and Barnabé eitoucha are two sons of Kikwanou.

Pentske Mitchitiou—"the eagle."

{ His wife is named mischitia; she does not recall her name or her Baptism, but she is very old.

His son is named Louis chakaragou; I Baptized him two years ago, october 7, 1671.

{ Kwetinaou, an old woman, does not recall her Baptism, although she is Baptized, as has been affirmed to me by a Savage woman; I am told the same concerning mischitia—that she has been elsewhere Baptized by our fathers.

{ Bernardin, a little boy, was Baptized by me June 3, 1673; his godfather was de Beau-lieu; the Savages call the boy mou-techa.

Joseph Wautichiou—"has a cold hand"—Oupapinachiwi.
