Greatly oblige me. I shall endeavor to turn them to account, to the best of my ability, in determining the Longitudes of the new regions to which providence is sending me. I shall communicate whatever observations I may think likely to be received by you with satisfaction. For that matter, I cannot expect to receive before three or four years what I now take the liberty of asking from you, owing to the great distance which separates us.
