AGREEMENT WITH NORTH WEST COMPANY FOR SUPPLIES

Detroit Sep^r 26th 1789

Sir Agreeable to what I mentioned to you this morning I will Engage to Furnish the North West C^o Yearly for three Successive Years to Commence next Spring with Six hundred Bushells of Hulled Corn French Measure at two dollars per Bushell & Twelve Thousand Pounds French Weight of Flour at One Pound Sixteen Shillings New York Cur. per C^t french or 108 lbs. English, to be delivered free of Expences on Board their Vessell here they furnishing the Baggs the whole of which shall be ready by the last of June of each year
