BE IT REMEMBERED, that on the third day of December in the thirty third year of the reign of our Lord George the Third of Great Britain France and Ireland king Defender of the Faith & so forth, Mathew Dalson of Detroit Publican personally appeared before us John Askin & George Sharpe Esq^{rs} Justices of our said Lord the king assigned to keep the peace in the said District, and acknowledged himself to owe to our said Lord the king the sum of Ten Pounds of Lawful
