Memorandum of an Agreement between Alexander Henry Merch^t of Montreal, John Askin Senior and John Askin jun^r Merchants Detroit May 27 1795

Its Mutually agreed between the Parties that John Askin Purchases what Tracts of Land he can of the Indian Nation on the Miamis River and River au Huron on the best Terms he can for the Concerned the Whole purchase not to Exceed Three Hundred Pounds N. York Cur. all Expences Except those of Surveying Included which Purchase shall belong Equally to the Said Alexander Henry John Askin Senior and John Askin jun^r and Each pay One hundred Pounds for their Share of the same or in proportion if the
