## The Cass Manuscripts

The following documents were obtained from the French archives, by Hon. Lewis Cass, when minister to that country. They were loaned to Col. Whittlesey, for his perusal and translation, and he has kindly translated them, in part, for our Society. The first number of the series has been furnished in manuscript, the second to the fifth inclusive, originally appeared in the Green Bay Advocate, in the Spring of 1855, the sixth in the Ontonagon Miner, and the others in the Detroit Advertiser, in Dec. 1856, and Jan. 1857. The second paper of the series appeared in the first volume of our Society's Collections; but since obtaining the others of the series, it is thought best to republish it in its proper connection.
