

SUPPOSED SITE OF PERROT'S WINTER QUARTERS, 1685-36

The scene is about one mile north of the village of Trempealeau. The foreground is the Wisconsin side, looking south. What are supposed to be the relics of an early French post were unearthed in April, 1888, on the left bank near the head of the tongue of water in the centre of the picture. The site of the fort is the irregular triangular strip of mainland, lying between the railway curve and the river
