Whereas I have been inform'd from the Officers who Commanded the Out posts as well as from other persons con-  
sistent of your good Services last year in protecting the Officers, Soldiers &c. of the Garrison of  
Niagara ———— and in keeping them down to Neutral as far as the Limits of the Fort  
to charge any one of you having likewise witness'd the strenuous engagement of your  
the English before us at this place, I do therefore give you This Testimony of my Return for your  
Services and great behaviour

Niagara the first day of August 1764.
