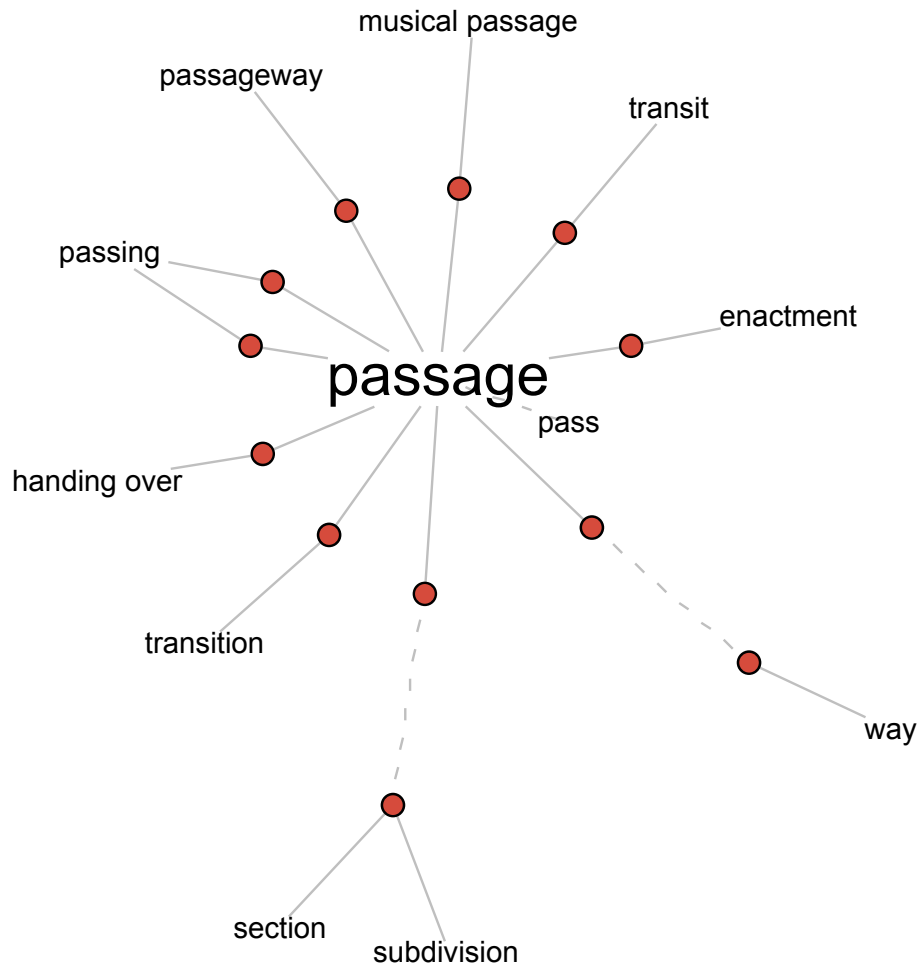

passage

● **passage, transition**

the act of passing from one state or place to the next

● **passage**

a section of text; particularly a section of medium length

● **passage**

a way through or along which someone or something may pass

● **enactment, passage**

the passing of a law by a legislative body

● **passage, transit**

a journey usually by ship

"the outward passage took 10 days"

● **musical passage, passage**

a short section of a musical composition

● **passage, passageway**

a path or channel or duct through or along which something may pass

"the nasal passages"

● **passage, passing**

a bodily process of passing from one place or stage to another

"the passage of air from the lungs"

"the passing of flatus"

● **passage, passing**

the motion of one object relative to another

"stellar passings can perturb the orbits of comets"

● **handing over, passage**

the act of passing something to another person
