How to get involved in the work at Lehman

God has equipped us all with different talents and abilities. Paul described the church as possessing members with different gifts in serving, teaching, exhorting, giving, leading, and ministering (Rom. 12:6-8). These are gifts present in the church globally and locally here at Lehman. We should acknowledge what God has blessed us with and realize that every member is important to God's work. Paul told the Corinthians that the church can be viewed as a human body in which every part of the body is essential and vital for survival (1 Cor. 12:14-31). It is not enough to know we have gifts that can benefit God's kingdom we must use what we have. Instead of neglecting our gifts (1 Tim. 4:14-15) we should fan them into flame through constant use and regular service (2 Tim. 1:6). You may have wanted to be more involved in the work here at Lehman and you are unsure of how to do that. Maybe you are trying to commit your life to more faithful service to Jesus but do not know where to start. We want to help you use your talents to benefit God's kingdom.

Here is one way to get involved in the work at Lehman Avenue: **Vision Groups**. We currently have seven different vision groups that are designed as outlets for service for members here to serve. Whether you feel like you could help with **Education, Local Outreach, Student Life, Media and Technology, Church Family, Missions**, or the **Cumberland Trace Relocation Effort** there is somewhere for you to serve. Consider reaching out to the different vision group leaders and asking them to put you to work. You may find that you can help in more than one vision group, that would be welcomed too! The vision groups help to unite the church's areas of service with the member's giftedness and areas of interest to the glory of God and the spreading of the gospel (Eph. 4:11-16). If you are looking for a way to serve, plug into one of these groups. If you are unfamiliar with these groups and want to know more ask any one of the elders, ministers, or deacons and we'd love to help point you in the right direction. Perhaps you expressed interest in the past but have not acted on it, change that this week. Maybe you said you would serve in a group but have not contributed yet, you still can. God is always looking to enlist more workers in his kingdom, we just must be willing to work!
