## How to get involved in the work at Lehman Hiram Kemp

Paul described the church as possessing members with different gifts in serving, teaching, exhorting, giving, leading, and ministering (Rom. 12:6-8). Paul told the Corinthians that the church can be viewed as a human body in which every part of the body is essential and vital for survival (1 Cor. 12:14-31).
