## ALPINE CITY COUNCIL MEETING Alpine City Hall, 20 North Main, Alpine, UT September 18, 2012

**I. CALL MEETING TO ORDER:** Mayor called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

**II. PUBLIC COMMENT:** Mayor Willoughby said there was a request by a resident to use the rodeo grounds for a "Sweet Sixteen" party on September 21st. The ordinance governing the rodeo grounds for such purposes required approval by the City Council. The Mayor said he was in favor of letting them use the rodeo grounds. Otherwise it sat empty.
