



ALPINE CITY COUNCIL TRUTH IN TAXATION HEARING

NOTICE is hereby given that the **CITY COUNCIL** of Alpine City, Utah will hold a **Truth in Taxation Hearing** on **TUESDAY, August 16, 2011** at **7:00 pm** at Alpine City Hall, 20 North Main, Alpine, Utah.

TRUTH IN TAXATION HEARING: Alpine City is proposing to increase its property tax revenue.

- The Alpine City tax on a \$410,000 residence would increase from \$288.19 to \$421.69, which is \$133.50 per year.
- The Alpine City tax on a \$410,000 business would increase from \$532.98 to \$766.70, which is \$242.72 per year.
- If the proposed budget is approved, Alpine City would increase its property tax budgeted revenue by 46.06% above last year's property tax budgeted revenue excluding new growth.
- Alpine City property tax revenue from new growth and other sources will increase from \$711,940 to \$1,040,052.
