US Figure Skating & Murray Silver Blades FSC Waiver and Release and Assumption of Risk Agreement

In consideration of me being permitted to participate in any way in the **U.S. Figure Skating** and **Murray Silver Blades FSC** sponsored Activities ("Activity"), I agree:

- 1. I fully understand that: (a) U.S. Figure Skating and Murray Silver Blades FSC activities involve risks and dangers of Serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis and death ("risks"); (b) these risks and dangers may be caused by my own actions, or inaction's, the actions or inaction's of others participating in the Activity, the condition in which the Activity takes place, or THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" NAMED BELOW; (c) there may be other risks and social and economic losses either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I FULLY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS AND ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSSES, COSTS AND DAMAGES incurred as a result of my Participation in the Activity.
- 2. I HEREBY RELEASE, DISCHARGE, COVENANT NOT TO SUE, AND AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS MURRAY SILVER BLADES FSC, their respective administrators, directors, agents, officers, volunteers, and employees, other participants, any sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises on which the Activity takes place (each considered one of the "Releasees" herein) from all liability, claims, demands, losses, or damages on my account caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the "Releasees" or otherwise, including negligent rescue operations and further agree that if, despite this release, I, or anyone on my behalf makes a claim against any of the Releasees named above, I WILL INDEMNIFY, SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS EACH OF THE RELEASEES FROM ANY LITIGATION EXPENSES, ATTORNEY FEES, LOSS LIABILITY, DAMAGE OR COSTS THAT MAY INCUR AS THE RESULT OF ANY SUCH CLAIM.

I understand the nature of U.S. FIGURE SKATING and MURRAY SILVER BLADES FSC activities and the Minor's experience and capabilities and believe the Minor to be qualified to participate in such Activity. I further acknowledge that I and the Minor are aware the activity will be conducted in facilities open to the public during the Activity. I further agree and warrant and will instruct the Minor that if at any time the Minor believes conditions to be unsafe, he/she will immediately discontinue further participation in the Activity.

I HAVE READ THIS AGREEMENT, FULLY UNDERSTAND IT'S TERMS, UNDERSTAND THAT I AND THE MINOR HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT AND HAVE SIGNED IT FREELY AND WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT OR ASSURANCE OF ANY NATURE AND INTEND IT TO BE A COMPLETE AND UNCONDITIONAL RELEASE OF ALL LIABILITY TO THE GREATEST EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW AND AGREE THAT IF ANY RELEASE OF ALL LIABILITY TO THE GREATEST EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW AND AGREE THAT IF ANY PORTION OF THIS AGREEMENT IS HELD TO BE INVALID THAT THE BALANCE, NOTWITHSTANDING, SHALL CONTINUE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

### **CODE OF CONDUCT**

Due to certain trends in youth sports whereby both parents and Members are letting their emotions manifest themselves in abusive and sometimes physical violence, the Murray Silver Blades FSC supports a zero tolerance policy for unsportsmanlike behavior. Its Members, coaches and parents (if Member is under 18 years old) should continually raise the standard of behavior – both on and off the ice.

Membership in the Murray Silver Blades FSC is a privilege and should carry a sense of pride. Participation in programs offered will require that members and parents (of Members under 18 years old) accept certain responsibilities.

### Members Responsibilities:

I will not verbally or physically abuse any of my fellow members, other USFSA members, USFSA officials, club Board members, volunteers, or coaches.

I understand that poor sportsmanship, on or off ice, will not be tolerated.

### Parents/Guardian Responsibilities:

I will encourage sportsmanship by showing positive support for all Members, coaches, Board Members and other officials during all on and off ice sessions.

I will encourage my child to treat all other Members, coaches, Board Members, other Member's parents and other officials with respect.

I will refrain from coaching my child or "manipulating" other Members during any on and off ice sessions.

I will not verbally or physically abuse any club Members (including my own child), coaches, club Board Members, officials, other parents, or volunteers.

I will represent myself positively and not undermine the authority of coaches, club Board Members, officials, or other club volunteers.

### Course of Action:

Should a parent or Member not adhere to the above, the Murray Silver Blades Board of Directors holds the Member and/or parent accountable and the Board of Directors is empowered to take necessary action. Actions could be as simple as a verbal warning to the parent or Member up to disciplinary hearings before the Board of Directors leading to suspension or expulsion from the Murray Silver Blades FSC.

### Implementation:

Anyone may file a complaint, in writing and signed, to the President of the MSBFSC.

# Club Ice Rules and Fees

Ice rules are necessary to keep a program running smoothly and to ensure that every participant receives equal consideration. The local situation and any rules in effect at an arena will determine which rules, if any, are feasible to incorporate into a program structure. Typical rules are listed below as guidelines only.

#### Club Ice

- Club Ice differs from Freestyle sessions provided by the County Ice Center. For Club Ice, a monitor will be present to facilitate registration.
- Skaters must be current Full, Associate, or Supporting members of the Club to attend and participate in Club Ice.
- Club Ice is held each Tuesday from 5:15 6:45pm at the County Ice Center, beginning in September and ending in June.
- Club Ice is generally reserved as a 30 min. freestyle session for skaters who have passed PrePre Freeskate, followed by a 30 min. specialty class or activity for all levels, followed by a 30 min. freestyle session for skaters below PrePre level. Skaters age 13 & up may choose to skate the first freestyle session.
- The freestyle sessions can be used for lessons. The Club reserves the right to use this time for Club business or activities as deemed necessary.
- Pros who are members may teach for free during this time. Non-member Pros must pay a Club Ice fee to teach during this time.
- Club Ice prices are as follows:
  - Year Pre-Paid (first week of September first week of June) \$140.00
  - o Per Session \$6.00

### **Club Ice Registration**

- Every member must check in with the Ice Monitor prior to entering the rink for the session.
- Every member must pay for the session prior to taking the ice. If this does not happen, the Ice Monitor is responsible for seeking payment. This may include approaching the member with a verbal request, or mailing a written request. Consequences for being in arrears on Club Ice fees include restriction from participation in Club Ice, as well as discipline per the Club Bylaws.

### County Ice Center Freestyle Sessions and Registration

- Schedules with Freestyle Ice are available at all rinks. Ice blocks are usually in 45-minute or 1-hour sessions.
- Occasionally Freestyle Ice is sold or becomes available, so updated schedules should be checked for frequently.
- Each session is paid for separately. Skaters must pay for each session they use, even if they only skate a portion of that session and a portion of another.
- Skaters must pay the County Ice Center and sign in before taking the ice; and they should not stay on the ice for a session longer than paid for. The Club could be in danger of losing the Freestyle ice sessions if advantage is taken.
- Fees for private lessons will be paid directly to the Pro. Pro fees DO NOT include ice fees.

### **General Rules**

- Safe skating is essential. All club members are expected to be considerate of other skaters at all times.
- No hockey sticks or pucks, or food is allowed on figure skating ice.
- No socializing. Standing is allowed only next to the barrier.
- No loitering in the rink during club ice. Skaters participating in club ice are expected to participate in the on or off ice activities.

#### Free Skating

- Not to exceed twenty-five skaters on the ice. The County Ice Center allows all skating levels on the ice during Freestyle Ice, but some area rinks divide their freestyle sessions into Low Test and High Test.
- A skater's music may be played during Freestyle Ice by the music monitor (or a Pro or skater if no monitor is present).
- Programs are played by rotation in the order the music is turned in.
- The first program music will commence after a five-minute warm-up.
- Any member wishing to practice a free-skating program will have the right of way during their program music.

The Murray Silver Blades FSC requires **10 hours** of parental volunteer time *per family* for full and second club members. Members joining after January 1st are required to give **5 hours**.
