TIME AND PLACE

Pre-service **prayer meeting** will be held at **1:15PM** behind the building with social-distancing seating.

The **service** will be at **2 PM** and will be finished at about 3:30 PM.

WHAT TO EXPECT

In many ways the service will be the same as we had before the lockdown.

A person will be assigned as **health officer** and will oversee all health regulations are honoured.

The **attendance will be limited to 50** individuals in total. Please RSVP to Andrew so we do not restrict entry to anyone.

Visitors are welcome, please contact the pastor to add your number to the 50-person limit.

Each attendee's **attendance will be recorded** for follow-up in case of any one of us contracting COVID-19.

Each attendee will be **screened** with a no-contact body temperature guage.

Hand sanitisers will be available at all times, and will be required upon entry.

There will be **no vocal singing**, instead the songs will be read by the pastor for heart-singing and meditation.

No beverages or food will be served.

Children are permitted provided that they adhere to all regulations.

Families will be allowed to sit together as a family, but need to maintain social distancing to any other person or family.

HOW TO PREPARE

1. Bring your Bible
2. Keep in step with the self-control fruit of the Spirit (Gal 5:22-25) to restrain yourself in the physical expressions of love you normally show to one another.
3. Cover your nose and mouth with a mask at all times.
4. Maintain social distancing of 1.5 metres.
5. Sign in with the health officer.
