

## Job Hand-out – 2 : Theme & Purpose

The proper relationship between GOD and mankind is that of:

- 1. sovereign grace from God, and
- 2. faith and submission from man.



### Right relationship from Man → God:

- Job 1:22 In all this Job did not sin or charge God with wrong.
- Job 40:4 Behold, I am of small account; what shall I answer you? I lay my hand on my mouth.
- Job 42:5-6 I had heard of you by the hearing of the ear, but now my eye sees you; therefore I despise myself, and repent in dust and ashes.

### Right relationship from God → Man:

- Job 40:1-2 And the Lord said to Job: "Shall a faultfinder contend with the Almighty? He who argues with God, let him answer it."
- Job 42:2 I know that you can do all things, and that no purpose of yours can be thwarted.

### And when this is properly understood and practised:

Job 28:28 Behold, the fear of the Lord, that is wisdom, and to turn away from evil is understanding.
