

Presidential 2:52 Scholarship

AMOUNTS: This would be a \$50,000 plus scholarship over 4 years.

The scholarship is for full tuition up to 16 credit hours per semester - awarded for 4 years for incoming freshman level students and for 2 years for students transferring in with a 2 year associate degree. The award amount is not to exceed full tuition per semester.

REQUIREMENTS:

The recipient must meet several criteria to be eligible for this scholarship.

1. Must submit two letters of recommendation. Acceptable references include community leader (teacher, counselor, minister, or employer), trustee, director, faculty member. The letter must state clearly why the applicant is worthy of this scholarship citing the applicant's specific outstanding achievements (example: awards or special recognition) in his/her spiritual, physical, mental, or social life. Both letters must be from persons unrelated to the applicant.
2. Must demonstrate outstanding achievement in at least one area (spiritual, physical, mental or social life) - showing the potential to become extraordinary Christian leaders
3. Must have an incoming minimum unweighted high school GPA of 2.5
4. Must submit a 500-700 word paper explaining why they should receive the scholarship
5. Must live in the dorm and be on the University meal plan
6. Must volunteer to work on-campus 8-10 hours each week to maintain scholarship eligibility
7. Must maintain a minimum term or cumulative 3.0 GPA while enrolled at MACU and be working towards a Bachelor degree for continued scholarship eligibility
8. Must be full time (at least 12 credit hours) each semester

PROCEDURES AND DEADLINES:

Application deadline: April 1

Awarding deadline: April 30

Acceptance deadline: May 15

The one-time non-refundable \$250 Scholarship Confirmation Fee must be sent in with the applicant's scholarship acceptance (can be applied towards housing charges).

Applicants must be fully accepted by the initial awarding deadline of April 30 to be considered for this scholarship.

A Limited number of scholarships offered at the sole discretion of the University.

Those applying are strongly encouraged to have an on-campus visit.

To receive the full award amount, the recipient must complete the semester. If the recipient withdraws from college prior to the end of any semester, this scholarship award will be prorated for that semester.
