Presidential Scholarship

Amount:

- \$50,000+ disbursed over 4 years
- Full Tuition up to 18 credits per semester—Awarded for 4 years for incoming freshmen level students and 2 years for students transferring in with an associate degree
- The award amount is not to exceed full tuition per semester

Qualifications:

- 1) Must have an incoming minimum unweighted GPA of 2.75
- 2) Must submit a 500-700 word paper explaining why they should receive the scholarship
- 3) Must submit 2 letters of recommendation. Letters CANNOT be from persons related to the applicant.
 - a. Acceptable references include: Community Leader (teacher, counselor, minister, or employer), Trustee, Director, or Faculty Member
 - b. Each letter must clearly state why the applicant is worthy of this scholarship citing the applicant's specific outstanding achievements (ex.: awards or recognition) in his/her spiritual, physical, mental, or social life.
- 4) Must demonstrate outstanding achievement in at least one area (spiritual, physical, mental, or social life) – showing the potential to become extraordinary Christian leaders
- 5) Must submit Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

Requirements:

- 1) Must live in the dorm and be on the University meal plan
- 2) Must volunteer to work on-campus 8-10 hours each week to maintain scholarship eligibility
- 3) Must maintain a minimum term or cumulative 2.75 GPA for your first semester and then a 3.0 GPA for all semesters that follow while enrolled at MACU
- 4) Must be enrolled full time (at least 12 credit hours) each semester in a degree seeking program

Deadlines:

- Applicants must be fully accepted to the University by April 1
- Scholarship application (letters of recommendation and essay) by April 15
- Scholarship award date of April 30
- Scholarship acceptance deadline and \$250 confirmation fee (can be applied towards housing) two weeks after awarding

Please Note:

- 1) There are a limited number of scholarships offered at the sole discretion of the University.
- 2) To receive the full award amount, the recipient must complete the semester. If the recipient withdraws from college prior to the end of the semester, this scholarship award will be prorated for that semester.
