Items of note:

Pre-report estimates jumped the gun a bit. US soybean carryout and Brazilian production reductions were both smaller than the expectations. South American weather is stabilizing, still dryish in southern BRZ with the prospects of increasing dryness in ARG. There seems to be an absence of extreme heat though. The old adage of a soybean rally lasting \$3 or 3 months probably holds currently; we may be high enough for now as the last time we had US carryout this tight, SA production was significantly less. Hard red wheat carryout raised 10 million bushels to 348 million.
