USA Upland and Pima Export Sales and Shipments for Week Ending April 27, 2017

Current crop sales were 153,990 bales. Current crop PLUS new crop sales were 251,240 bales.

Current crop sales were up 27% from last week and down 36% from the 4-week average. Current PLUS new crop sales were up 29% from last week and down 33% from the 4-week average.

Shipments of Upland and Pima were 375,340 bales, which was up 18% from last week and down 7% from the 4-week average

There are 13.6 weeks remaining in the 2016/17 marketing year.

To ship the USDA estimate of 14,000,000 bales for 2016/17 crop, the U.S. needs to sell approximately 56,100 bales per week, and needs to ship 254,000 bales per week.

Sales were 2.7 times the needed weekly pace. Shipments were 1.5 times the needed weekly pace.
