Corn and wheat closed lower today while soybeans closed higher. March corn closed down 4 cents at \$4.81 1/2, the lowest close in December. March corn prices have been gradually slipping lower since August, bounded by support from a downward channel line that is currently near \$4.69 and staying well below resistance from the 100-day average, which is currently near \$5.00. With USDA now estimating U.S. ending corn stocks at a five-year high of 2.13 billion bushels (bb), a break below support, should it happen, would add to bearish pressures.

January soybeans closed up 32 cents at \$13.36 Monday, finding support from its lowest prices in over a month and erasing last week's 21-cent loss in one swoop. The new forecast for central Brazil expects a return of hot temperatures and lighter rain amounts, starting Wednesday.










Grain Futures Closes - 12/11/2023
