Monday is President's Day—Markets are CLOSED

One day after the widely expected, but still bearish, USDA Ag Outlook balance sheet changes, corn and soy markets are still having to deal with the bearish fallout. All the markets not only have seen a large uptick in speculative short position, but also a technical picture that reflects oversold conditions. Funds are thought to be carrying record or nearrecord large net short positions in corn and soybeans ahead of President's Day. Spot corn futures again fell to a new contract low for the sixth time in eight days. Friday's weakness is still tied to the expected, but still bearish, USDA Outlook report, which showed the corn ending stocks rising by 360 mb to a lofty 2.534 bb number. A record large yield of 181 bushels per acre was used to arrive at the 15-billion-bushel crop. Just as in corn, soybeans weakened on Thursday following the USDA Ag Outlook projection for a record yield and 4.5billion-bushel soybean crop for 2024-25, sending ending stocks up to 435 mb and 120 mb higher than the current year. Soybean area was called 87.5 million acres and that would be 3.9 million acres higher than the current year.








Grain Futures Closes - 02/16/2024
