**Futures Closes** 


Grain futures were under pressure today amid concerns about US/China trade relations as the "blame game" around covid-19 garners attention.

Corn export inspections for the week ending 4/30 came in at 1.22 MMT, up from 1.08 MMT last week, with soybeans down from 561k to 318k tonnes, and wheat up slightly from 506k to 536k tonnes. National corn planting progress is expected to come in at 48% complete this afternoon, up from 27% last week, with soybeans seen at 21%, compared to 8% a week ago. The corn estimate range is from 42-58%, with the soybean range wide as well at 16-35%. Spring wheat plantings are seen at 30%, with winter wheat ratings falling a point to 53% g/ex.

Corn and soybean crops are going in at a rapid pace and weather is mostly crop friendly.






