


Old crop corn closed higher today while new crop corn, soybeans and wheat closed lower. In wheat there was some profit taking from recent highs and lack of Chinese business is still weighing on the soybean market. Commodity funds were net buyers of 4k corn contracts and net sellers of 5k soybean and wheat contracts.

Private analyst Agroconsult is reporting stronger-than-expected early soybean yields coming from Mato Grosso, Brazil at 10-15% better than last year; the state is initially expected to harvest 35 million tonnes this season, with total output estimated at 124.3 MMT by the firm, up from 119.0 MMT in 2018/19.

Commodity Weather Group notes that we are expected to go into the summer growing season in a neutral ENSO cycle, meaning equally between El Nino and La Nina. The current setup lacks a significant threat to limit yields.
