Today's Price Trend: Mostly Higher - Reason: grains benefit from bargain-buying after spot corn gets within a tick of \$3/bu (CK20).


Tomorrow is First Notice Day for May futures contracts. Most cash bids have rolled to the July futures price reference.

The weekly eIA report (see page 2) showed 53.7 mil bu of corn was used to make ethanol last week as average daily production remains at record low levels and ethanol stocks remain historically high.

USDA weekly export sales are expected to show weekto-week gains in the Export Sales Report tomorrow. Midday forecasts do see some wetter risks in the NE Midwest into the weekend and central/western belt past that, but widespread precip chances remain fairly slim







